As we bathe in the Easter Light of Resurrected Life, we walk the Way of Resurrection, touching our world with hope and healing, proclaiming to the world the Good News of Life in all its fulness.

Matt 28: 2

Luke 24: 2-6

The women found that the stone had been rolled away from the tomb, but on entering discovered that the body of the Lord Jesus was not there. They stood there not knowing what to think.


- V. WHY LOOK AMONG THE DEAD

Prayer: Lord, help us to find you in the emptiness, and to trust that you have conquered death for us. Teach us that just as the sun shines when we cannot see it, so You are Risen and with us even when we do not feel your Presence. Lord, increase our faith!

[3] THE WOMEN SEE THE ANGEL

Matt 28: 3-7

An Angel was sitting on the rolled away stone, his face was like lightening, his robe white as snow. The guards were so shaken, so frightened, that they were like dead men. But the angel said to the women, 'There is no need for you to be afraid. I know you are looking for Jesus, who was crucified. He is not here, for He is risen!' [4] PETER AND THE OTHER DISCIPLE RUN TO THE TOMB

John 20: 3-9

- R. HE IS TRULY RISEN!




The Women ran to tell Peter and the other disciple, the one Jesus loved: 'They have taken the Lord out of the tomb and we do not know where they have put him!' The two disciples ran together to the tomb. Peter went into the tomb first and saw the linen cloths. The other disciple now went in - he saw and he believed. Now they understood the teaching of the scriptures, that He must rise from the dead'

- V. HE SAW AND HE BELIEVED

Prayer: Lord, give us the love to run to you, to gaze into the emptiness, experience Your Presence and believe with all our heart that you are with us, forever!

Mary stayed outside, weeping. Then the two angels in white said, 'Woman, why are you weeping?' 'Thy have taken my Lord away...' She turned round and mistaking Jesus for the gardener, asked 'Where have you put Him?'. And Jesus said, 'Mary!' She knew him then and cried out 'Rabbuni', 'Master'. Jesus said, 'Do not cling to Me, but go and tell the brothers!'


- V. DO NOT CLING TO ME

[6] THEY RECOGNISE HIM IN THE BREAKING OF BREAD

Luke 24: 13-35

In that same first evening, two disciples were on the road to Emmaus and a stranger came up and asked, 'Why are you so downcast?' And they told him about Jesus, their Hope, who had been crucified and about the empty tomb. The stranger, Jesus, said, 'But it was ordained that the Christ should suffer and so enter into His glory!' They came to the village and pressed him to stay. At the table Jesus broke the bread and gave it to them, and their eyes were opened - they recognised Him, alive, in the 'Breaking of Bread'.

- V. DID NOT OUR HEARTS BURN WITHIN US
- R. AS HE TALKED TO US ON THE WAY, ALLELUIA!

Prayer: Lord, take from our eyes the dark veil that we might ever see you at our side; and help us listen to the pain of the world with your heart of healing love.

[7] PETER SEES THE RISEN LORD

Luke 24: 33-34 & 1 Cor 15: 5

- R. HE IS TRULY RISEN!




The two disciples set out from Emmaus that instant and returned to the Eleven and their companions in Jerusalem. These told them 'Yes it is true, The Lord has risen and has appeared to Simon'. Then the two disciples told them how they had recognised Him in the 'Breaking of Bread'.

 John 20: 19-21
 - V. JESUS IS RISEN!
 - R. HE IS TRULY RISEN!



In the evening of that first day of the week, the doors were closed for fear of the Jewish authorities. Jesus came and stood among them. He said 'Shalom! Peace be with you!' and showed them His hands and feet. They were filled with joy! He then said, 'As the Father has sent me, so I am sending you' and breathing on them, he said, 'Receive the Holy Spirit...'

- V. SHALOM! PEACE BE WITH YOU
- R. AS THE FATHER SENT ME, SO I SEND YOU, ALLELUIA!

Prayer: Lord, unlock the prison of our fears and set our hearts free. Breathe again Your Holy Spirit into us, that we might dare to believe, dare to proclaim and dare to build Your New Creation.

- [9] THOMAS TOUCHES THE WOUNDS AND BELIEVES
- John 20: 24-29

A week later, Thomas rejoined the community. 'I will not believe until I see the holes the nails have made and touch the wounds!' The doors were still closed, but Jesus came in and stood among them. 'Shalom! Peace be with you. Come, Thomas, touch my wounds. Doubt no longer, but believe!' And Thomas said, 'My Lord and my God!'


- V. PUT YOUR FINGER HERE, GIVE ME YOUR HAND
- R. DOUBT NO MORE, BUT BELIEVE, ALLELUIA!

Prayer: Lord, in the midst of all our doubts, give us the courage to let you touch our wounds, so that we might touch the wounds of our sisters and brothers with your healing love!

[10] THEY MEET HIM IN GALILEE AND ARE HEALED

John 21: 1-14

Jesus stood on the shore, though they did not realise it was Him. 'Have you caught anything, friends?' They replied 'No'. 'Throw the net to starboard and you will find something.' - R. HE IS TRULY RISEN!





[12] HE ASCENDS AND THEY GO EVERYWHERE PROCLAIMING Luke 24: 45-53

- R. HE IS TRULY RISEN!





[13] PAUL MEETS THE RISEN LORD ON THE DAMASCUS ROAD 1 Cor 15: 8-10

'And last of all He appeared to me too; it was as though I was born when no one expected it'...Suddenly, while Paul was travelling to Damascus, there came a light from heaven all round him. He fell to the ground and heard a voice: "Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting Me?" and Paul asked "Who are You?" "I am Jesus whom you are persecuting."

- V. I HAVE BEEN SENT TO YOU BY THE RISEN JESUS
- R. GAIN YOUR SIGHT BE FILLED WITH THE SPIRIT, ALLELUIA!

Give us hearts open to every human person that we might recognise you, crucified and risen among our suffering sisters and brothers. May we shine with the Light of Your love and so become Good News of New Life for all the world.
